00. FORMULA STUDENT SPAIN

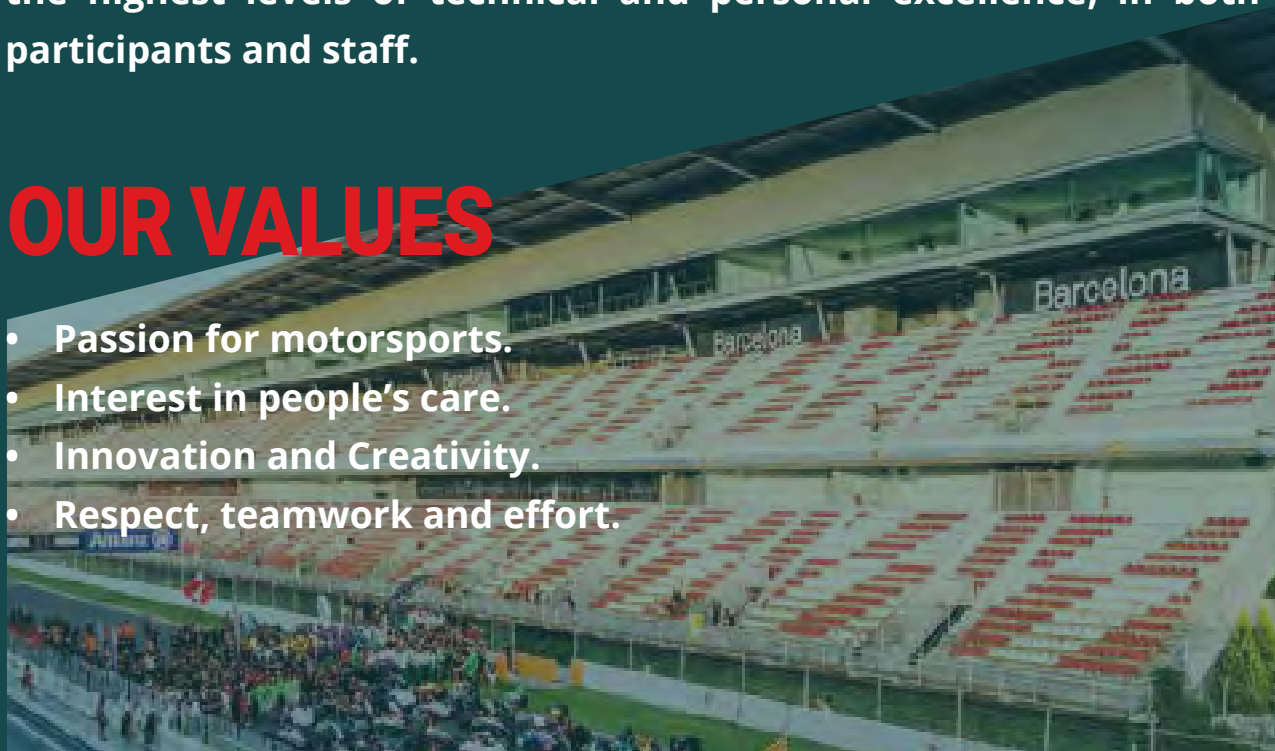

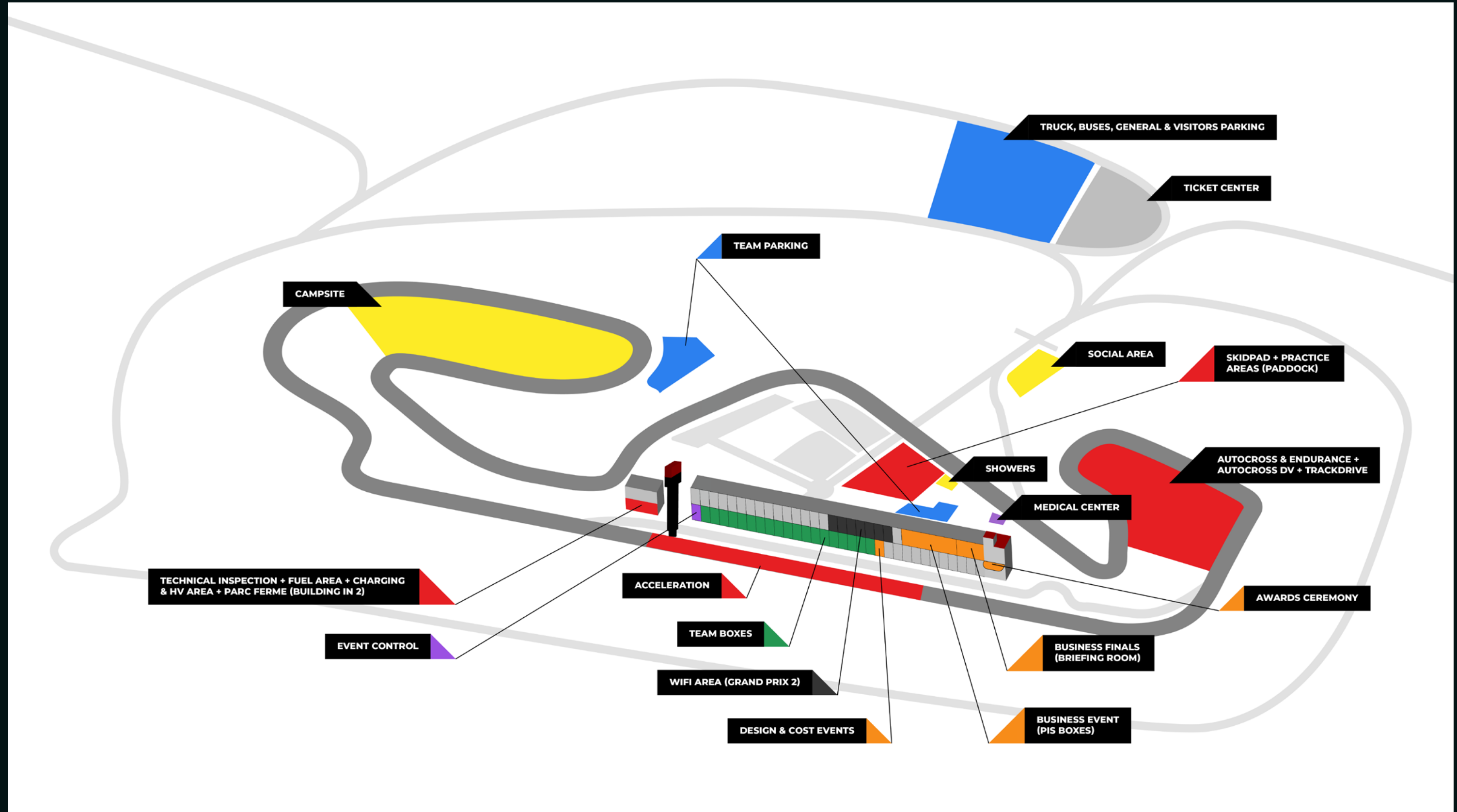

- SMALL TRUCKS AND VANS ARE ALLOWED TO ACCESS THE Paddock ONLY WITH ONE OF THE VEHICLE'S PASSES.
- PASSENGER VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED TO ACCESS THE Paddock ONLY WITH ONE OF THE VEHICLE'S PASSES.

Social Area Vehicle Restrictions:

- TRAILER, BIG TRUCKS AND BUSES ARE ALLOWED TO ACCESS THE SOCIAL AREA ONLY FOR LOADING/UNLOADING AND WITH THE APPROPRIATE VEHICLE PASS.
- SMALL TRUCKS AND VANS ARE ALLOWED TO ACCESS THE SOCIAL AREA ONLY FOR LOADING/UNLOADING AND WITH THE APPROPRIATE VEHICLE PASS.
- PASSENGER VEHICLES ARE ALLOWED TO ACCESS THE SOCIAL AREA ONLY FOR LOADING/UNLOADING AND WITH THE APPROPRIATE VEHICLE PASS.

Campsite Vehicle Restrictions:

- TRAILER, BIG TRUCKS AND BUSES ARE FORBIDDEN TO ACCESS THE CAMPSITE & SOCIAL AREA.
- SMALL TRUCKS AND VANS CAN ACCESS THE CAMPSITE & SOCIAL AREA ONLY IF THEY MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:
 - o Weight below 2.5 tones
 - o Height below 2.3 m
 - o Width below 2.5 m
 - o Valid Vehicle Pass
- PASSENGER VEHICLES CAN ACCESS THE CAMPSITE & SOCIAL AREA ONLY WITH ONE OF THE VEHICLE'S PASSES.
- UNDER REQUEST ONLY: SMALL TRUCKS AND VANS WITH A WEIGHT OVER 2.5 TONES AND/OR A HEIGHT OVER 2.3 M, SHALL REQUEST ACCESS AT EVENT CONTROL TO THE CAMPSITE & SOCIAL AREA AND WAIT FOR A RESPONSE FROM OFFICIALS. THE FSS ORGANIZATION CAN REJECT THE REQUEST.

Campsite & Social Area will only be accessible to vehicles on 04/08/2025 and 11/08/2025 for loading/unloading. No vehicles are allowed to stay in the campsite during the rest of the days.

If a team requires access to the campsite on the 10/08/2025 night it shall request it to the FSS organization via email (fss@formulastudent.es) and wait for FSS official authorization. The FSS organization can reject the request.

There will be a Campsite Parking located at a 5-minute walk to the Campsite Area. Access to this campsite will be available during the full duration of the competition. The relevant Team Parking Vehicle Pass is required to park the vehicle there.

04.5. DRIVERS REGISTRATION

Driver registration will take place at Event Control on Tuesday 5th August 2025 at 10:00h. All approved drivers will receive wristbands to identify them after the verification of the following documents:

- Valid Government Driver's license
- Valid National ID card or passport
- Valid student ID

Teams which are scheduled in scrutineering prior to the Drivers Registration can be registered during 4th of August 2025 at Event Control.

04.6. ESO REGISTRATION

Electrical System Officer registration will take place at Event Control on Tuesday 5th August 2025 at 11:30h. Each team will receive an ESO bracelet to identify them after the verification of the following documents:

- Valid ESOQ
- Valid student ID

Teams which have an earlier slot in Accumulator Inspection and/or Electrical Inspection than the ESO Registration scheduled time, will be allowed to register the ESOs during 4th August 2025 at Event Control.

All ESOs whose phone number are displayed on a TSAC lid or on a handcart must be reachable at all times during the competition and in full possession of their faculties throughout the entire competition. Failure to comply with these guidelines will occur on a points penalty or the disqualification of the team as specified in section 7 Event Guidelines of the Handbook FSS 2025.

04.7. ASR REGISTRATION

Autonomous System Responsible registration will take place at Event Control on Tuesday 5th August 2025 at 11:30h. Each team will receive an ASR bracelet to identify them after the verification of the following documents:

- Valid ASRQ
- Valid student ID

All ASR from teams taking part in both EV&DV classes must be reachable at all times during the competition and in full possession of their faculties throughout the entire competition. Failure to comply with these guidelines will occur on a points penalty or the disqualification of the team as specified in section 7 Event Guidelines of the Handbook FSS 2025.

04.8. VISITORS

- Visitors will only be allowed to enter the Circuit of Barcelona-Catalunya between Thursday 7th of August until Sunday 10th of August 2025.
- The visitors opening times will be confirmed on the FSS website.
- The visitors will need to request a digital ticket on the FSS website. This ticket will be requested at the Circuit of Barcelona-Catalunya entrance.
- No visitor vehicles are allowed to enter at the Circuit of Barcelona-Catalunya and these vehicles shall be parked at the Truck, Buses and General Parking near the Main Entrance and the Registration Center.
- If a visitor requires to access the Circuit of Barcelona-Catalunya via vehicle (for example, due to a disability), the visitor or the team shall send a request via email at fss@formulastudent.es. If the petition is accepted, the FSS organization will grant a Vehicle Pass for that visitor which shall be returned when the visitor leaves the Circuit.
- Visitors do not have access to the Campsite & Social areas.

06. GENERAL GUIDELINES

06.1. ANNOUNCEMENTS

The FSS event will comply with the FS Spain Rules 2025 and with general guidelines provided in the FSS Handbook in this section and also other sections.

FSS event updates and other important information will be included in the Daily Teams Briefing presentations that will be sent to every team before the opening of the Pit Boxes of that day. It is mandatory for the Team Leaders, Drivers of that day, ESOs and ASRs to read the Daily Teams Briefing presentation. These daily briefings will be shared with teams via email and other channels.

There will not be in-person Team Briefings at FSS 2025 event.

The official channel for FSS event updates will be:

- WhatsApp Team Leaders Group
- Event Control Notice Board
- FSS E-mail to all Team Leaders
- Daily briefing presentation

As it has been stated in the FS Spain Rules 2025, if a team does not follow the guidelines included in the FSS Handbook the team may receive a points penalty at the discretion of the officials. Furthermore, if a team member fails to follow a direct instruction from the FSS officials the team will receive a penalty.

The penalty points will comply with the following type depending on the severity of the behavior of the team.

Behavior Severity	Penalty Decision
Low	1-5 points
Moderate	5-25 points
High	50 points
Critical	Team's disqualification from the FSS event

**If a team receives two High Severity warnings it will be considered as a Critical Warning.*

06.2. SURVEILLANCE

Each team is responsible for the security of its car and the equipment in its pits. Do not leave any visible valuable in your pit box at any time. The FSS organization is not responsible for any damage or loss of property.

06.3. FIRES AND SMOKING

No open fires are allowed in the PIT AREA & ENGINE TEST AREA. This includes BBQ grilles, oxy-acetylene torches, heaters, cigarettes, etc.

Smoking is strictly prohibited in the DYNAMIC AREA, all BUILDINGS and the PIT AREA. There will be clear Smoking Areas marked inside the Circuit.

06.4. FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

The team fire extinguishers must be accessible at any time. All team members must be familiar with their use. At least one fire extinguisher must accompany the car wherever it goes.

06.5. ALCOHOLIC DRINKS

FORBIDDEN

Alcoholic drinks are completely forbidden inside the competition area. If a team does not respect this rule, they will receive a **penalty** for not following the guidelines.

ALLOWED

The alcoholic drinks are allowed inside the campsite and social areas. Every participant will be accounted responsible of their acts.

06.6. TRANSPONDERS

The exact times for the delivery of transponders will be communicated to teams during the FSS event via the daily FSS Team briefings.

06.7. PADDOCK FOOTWEAR

It is forbidden to use flipflops in the Paddock Area and the Dynamic Areas. Only closed footwear is allowed in the Paddock Area and the Dynamic Areas.

06.8. CAMPSITE GENERAL GUIDELINES

Teams shall adhere to the Campsite General Guidelines included in this document. In this edition, the FSS organization will monitor the behavior of all the team members located in the campsite.

Furthermore, the FSS organization requests teams to make a reasonable use of water, since Catalonia has experienced a severe drought in previous years. Furthermore, it is not allowed to have showers in the campsite area. For this reason, the Circuit allows the use of the building located in the Paddock for showers (review site plan). Furthermore, the FSS organization requests teams to guarantee the environmental protection of the campsite area.

The Campsite Area will be opened from Monday 04/08/2025 10:00 until Monday 11/08/2025 12:00. The Campsite lights will be switched off at 23:00h. Teams shall clear the campsite area and circuit premises before 11/08/2025 12:00. It is important for teams to leave their Campsite & Social areas in a clean condition. The same applies to the team's Pit Box.

The Social Area will be opened until 2 am from Monday 04/08/2025 until Saturday 09/08/2025. On Sunday 10/08/2025 the Social Area will be opened until 3 am. Anyone remaining in the Social Area after these hours will receive a penalty for not following the Handbook Guidelines.

Cleaning services are planned daily. It only includes floor sweeping and garbage bin collection. Teams are not allowed to leave any garbage on the tables. Please, keep the space and tables clean when you finish their use.

POOLS:

Due to the limited space in the Social Area, pools are not allowed.

BBQ:

Due to the high heat weather conditions, the use of barbecues in the Social Area is strictly forbidden. FSS Organization will inform in the briefing presentations if the decision changes.

The use of portable stoves using propane or butane gas is permitted only for cooking purposes. Electric cookers are also permitted. **IMPORTANT: Each team must have a bucket filled with water next to the cooking equipment in case of any kind of fire related issue.**



06.9. WEATHER CONDITIONS GUIDELINES

Your safety is our top priority. As the event takes place during August, we kindly ask all teams to be aware of the following precautions in case of severe weather conditions:

HEAT WAVES



- **Seek shade** and avoid direct sunlight as much as possible, especially during peak hours.
- **Apply sunscreen** regularly to protect your skin.
- **Stay hydrated** – drink plenty of water throughout the day.
- Wear **light, breathable clothing** and a **hat or cap** to protect yourself from sun exposure.
- Avoid excessive physical activity when temperatures are highest.
- Pay attention to **symptoms of heat exhaustion** (dizziness, fatigue, nausea) and seek help from FSS staff if needed.

HEAVY RAINS OR THUNDERSTORMS



- Stay **alert and cautious**, especially around slippery or uneven surfaces.
- Seek shelter in designated safe areas if necessary.
- In case of windy conditions be aware of prioritizing your safety over your personal belongings and seek for shelter if necessary.
- Follow all **official instructions** and announcements from FSS organization.

EVENT SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENTS

Please note that the event schedule may be modified depending on weather conditions. Updates will be communicated promptly via FSS official channels.

08. TECHNICAL INSPECTION

The Scrutineering schedule with the slots for all teams will be available at the FSS website.

08.1. INSPECTION RESPONSIBLE PERSON

To make the inspection process smooth, the team must appoint one team member prior to start who will be responsible and the main contact window for the Scrutineer. It is not required to be the same person for all of the inspection parts (e.g. member A for Accumulator and member B for Mechanical).

IRP must be familiar with the car and the inspection sheet, being able to show the compliance of the car and assure it is ready for inspection. Also, this person may have to perform the technical inspection autonomously under supervision of the Scrutineer.

If IRP is not able to perform any of these requirements or it is considered the car is not in Ready-to-Race conditions, the inspection will be stopped, and the team must go back to the box.

08.2. RE-INSPECTION

When a team is ready for Re-Inspection, they must request a slot at the entrance of the Technical Inspection area and an Official will check the expected time for their inspection in order to make the process efficient. Once the slot time is defined, the team will be included in the Re-Inspection queue.

The organization will try to communicate transparently the estimated waiting time for re-inspection. If a team is not present at the entrance with the car in Ready-to-Race conditions when it is their turn, they will lose their slot and rule A 3.4.1 may apply.

If during the inspection the Scrutineer considers the team has not attempted to fix all open points, the inspection will be stopped, the team must go back to the box and rule A 3.4.1 may apply.

08.3. ACCUMULATOR SAFETY GUIDELINES

08.3.1: Rule ES IN 3.2.10 applies at the time the accumulator is brought into the event. The designated area for the accumulator reception is Building IN2.

08.3.2: The slot time to bring the accumulator to the designated area is from 19:30 to 20:00. The time slot to pick it up from the designated area is from 8:00 to 8:30. This includes the first day of the competition 04/08/2025 and the rest of days of the competition, except if indicated differently in the Event Schedule.

08.3.3: Accumulators must always be transported fully closed, fastened to the handcarts and covered with an HV blanket.

08.3.4: Accumulators must be brought into the competition with a State of Charge (SoC) within 25% and 70%. SoC will be checked during the accumulator reception. Teams are responsible for bringing all necessary equipment to display cell voltages and temperatures.

08.3.5: Accumulators must be brought into the competition with maintenance plugs disconnected.

08.3.6: Teams with accumulators that are fully sealed from a previous official FS competition may be exempt from 0.3.2 only after receiving officials' approval during the accumulator reception. Seals must be intact and clearly show that the accumulator was not opened in any way.

08.3.7: Any team unable to comply with 9.3.4 or 9.3.5 due to a sensible reason (e.g. it is unsafe to transport their accumulator without maintenance plugs) may request an exemption well in advance by providing a detailed explanation to accumulatorscrutineering@formulastudent.es and wait for confirmation.

08.3.8: Teams are encouraged to contact accumulatorscrutineering@formulastudent.es for advice on how to safely transport accumulators.

08.4. PARC FERME

All cars that complete the Endurance will be directed to go to the Parc Fermé.

The Data Logger responsible will collect the energy data from the cars there.

Any car (Combustion, Hybrid or Electric) can be inspected for rules compliance after the Endurance.

09. STATIC EVENTS

The Static Event schedule with the slots and location for each team will be available at the FSS website.

09.1. BUSINESS PLAN PRESENTATION EVENT

The following details are additional information to the FSS rules 2025 section ES S 1.5.

The Business Plan does not necessarily have to be directly related to the vehicle itself and can cover another satellite business idea to the vehicle.

Potential investors (the jury) will not only value that the Business Plan Presentation is perfectly executed, but will also take into account other critical aspects which will influence the “Content” scoring section of the Business Plan scoring included in article ES S.1.7.3 of the FSS Rules 2025 v3.0.20250324:

- Innovation and differentiation
- Relevance and problem solving
- Viability and profitability
- Alignment with the entrepreneur
- Market and competition
- Scalability
- Ease of use and adoption
- Sustainability
- Social and environmental impact

For the Business Plan Presentation event formal dressing is required.

The initial **General Team Introduction** (5 minutes) of the Business Plan Presentation is allocated for a general Business Plan presentation and a Team Introduction. Please remember that the mandatory Business Plan Pitch Video serves as the crucial first impression of your business idea and must include the relevant investment figures. You have complete flexibility regarding the content of both the Business Plan and Team introduction presentations. Include whatever information you believe is essential to effectively introduce yourselves and your business plan.

DEEP DIVE TOPIC

The Business Plan Event judges after receiving the Business Plan Executive Summary and the Business Plan Pitch Video will ask competitors to provide a specific Deep Dive Topic during the presentation. At FSS 2025 the proposed Deep Dive Topic is included as follows:

“Conduct a sensitivity analysis of the impact that Donald Trump’s new tariff policy may have on the business case”.

BUSINESS PLAN FINALS

The FSS organization will confirm in the daily briefings the exact location of the Business Plan Presentation Finals.

The Business Plan Presentation Finals are not a public event.

09.2. ENGINEERING DESIGN EVENT

09.3. COST & MANUFACTURING EVENT

COST REAL CASE

The Cost & Manufacturing Event Real Case is included as follows:

“Your Formula Student team is currently in the early stages of manufacturing this season’s car.

Recently, **three new members have joined** the team:

- **One member** with experience in **quality control**
- **Two members** with interest and skills in **manufacturing tasks**

You must analyze how to integrate these new members effectively into the project.

Your task is to:

1. **Propose a task distribution** for the three new members.
2. Evaluate and justify how their incorporation would impact:
 - **Cost**
 - **Performance**
 - **Quality**
 - **Manufacturing lead times**

Consider the current project timeline and available resources.”.

10. DYNAMIC EVENTS

At FSS 2025 there will be a unique in-person Dynamic Events Briefing. Due to the available space at the Briefing Room, two separate sessions for this Dynamic Events Briefing. The teams shall attend to the specific Briefing Session as specified as follows:

- Dynamic Events Briefing Session 1: Car Numbers 2 - 164
- Dynamic Events Briefing Session 2: Car Numbers 165 - 492

If a team cannot attend the Dynamic Event Briefing Sessions due to a clash with another FSS event in the schedule, it shall communicate this to an FSS Official at Event Control and a special Dynamic Event Briefing Session will take place for the team the next day.

LOCATION: BRIEFING ROOM

SCHEDULE: See schedule on section 3 or the FSS website

MANDATORY ATTENDEES:

- All Team Leaders
- Any Driver who wants to drive in any dynamic events
- [EV Only] At least one ESO, other ESOs can also come.
- [DV & EV Only] At least one ASR, other ASRs can also come.

BRIEFING OBJECTIVE: To present an overview of the event and details of each specific dynamic event.

TEAMS not attending the Dynamic Events Briefing will not be allowed to take part in the Dynamic Events of FSS 2025.

10.2. GENERAL INFORMATION

Practice Areas (Driver and Driverless), Welding Area, Engine Test Area, Brake Test Area, Charging & HV Area and Fuel Station are also considered as dynamic areas.

After any run the driver must leave the course and drive slowly back to the start line for the Second Run, to the Drive Charge or to the Exit Lane.

10.3. DYNAMIC EVENTS CLOSING TIME

The closing time will be updated in the Dynamic Event's entrance if the officials consider that a major incident has delayed the Dynamic Event's schedule.

Once the event closes, only the teams that are in the event's queue (prior to the pre-scrutineering) will be allowed to run. No teams will be allowed to join the event's queue after the closing time indicated at the Dynamic Event's entrance.

10.4. WEATHER CONDITIONS

Under normal conditions the track is declared dry.

If it is necessary to declare damp or wet conditions, there will be signs and announcements at the Dynamic Area of the Dynamic Event.
